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Central European Gas Hub with new all-time high at PEGAS CEGH Futures Market

- ▶ **In April 2018 4.8 TWh were nominated at the PEGAS CEGH Futures Market, an increase of 619% compared to 2017.**
- ▶ **48.3 TWh were nominated at the CEGH VTP, an increase of 8% compared to the previous year (April 2017)**
- ▶ **204 companies registered at CEGH VTP**

CEGH VTP Market:

The nominated gas volumes on the CEGH VTP reached an amount of 48.26 TWh in April 2018. This equals a plus of 7.5% compared to the previous year (April 2017). The Churn Rate was 3.23.

204 companies were registered at CEGH VTP by end of April 2018, including 4 new members in April.

PEGAS CEGH Market:

In April 2018, 10.78 TWh of natural gas were traded on the PEGAS CEGH Market. This is an increase of 161% compared to April 2017.

The Spot Market recorded a volume of 5.97 TWh in April 2018, an increase of 72% compared to April 2017. The PEGAS CEGH Futures Market reached volumes of 4.8 TWh in April 2018: a new all-time high in history, and an increase of 619% compared to the previous year and more than 50% more than the last all-time high in August 2017 (3.11 TWh).

PEGAS CEGH Czech Gas Market:

On the CEGH Czech Gas Exchange 302 GWh were traded in April 2018, almost twice the volume of April 2017. On the Spot Market 102 GWh were traded at the Czech Market, and 200 GWh were traded on the Futures Market.
